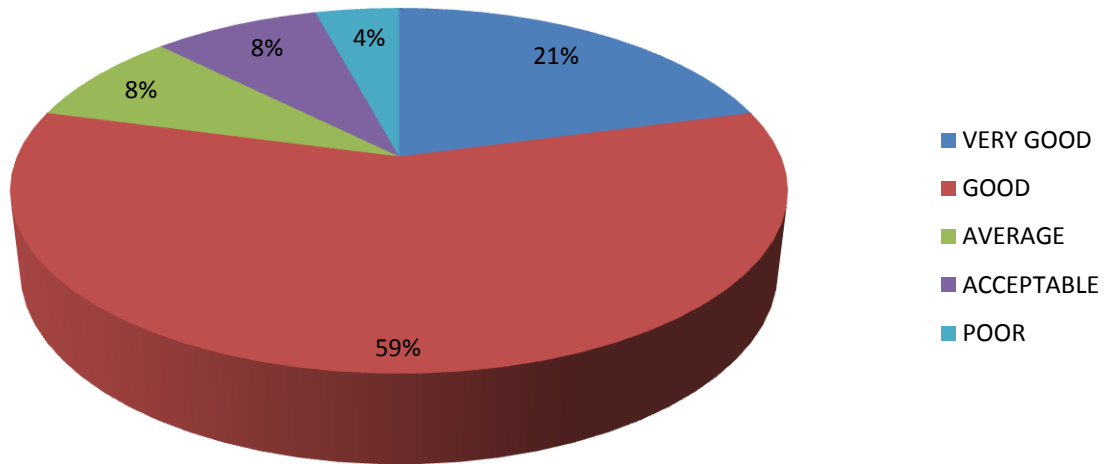

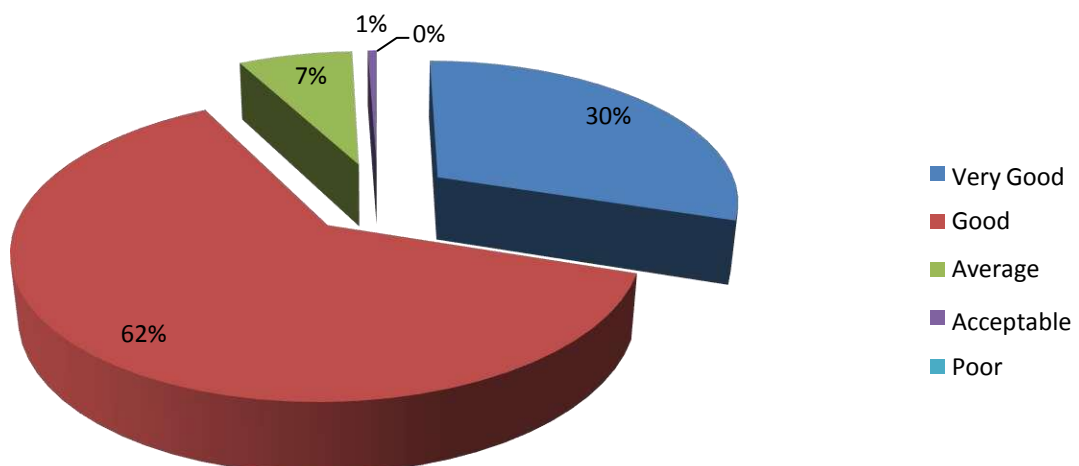
IS THE SYLLABUS CREATING INTEREST IN YOU

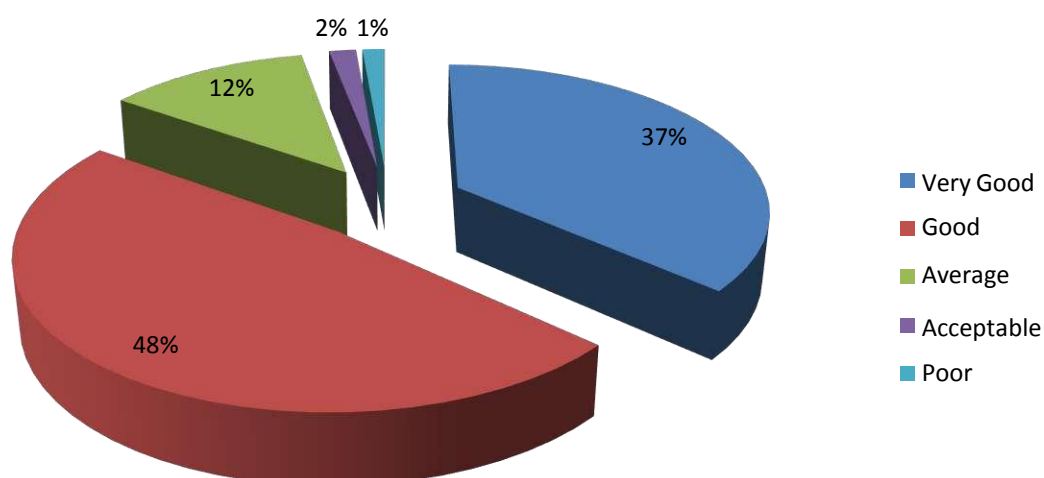
THE LINK BETWEEN THE CHAPTERS IS

Availability of reference books

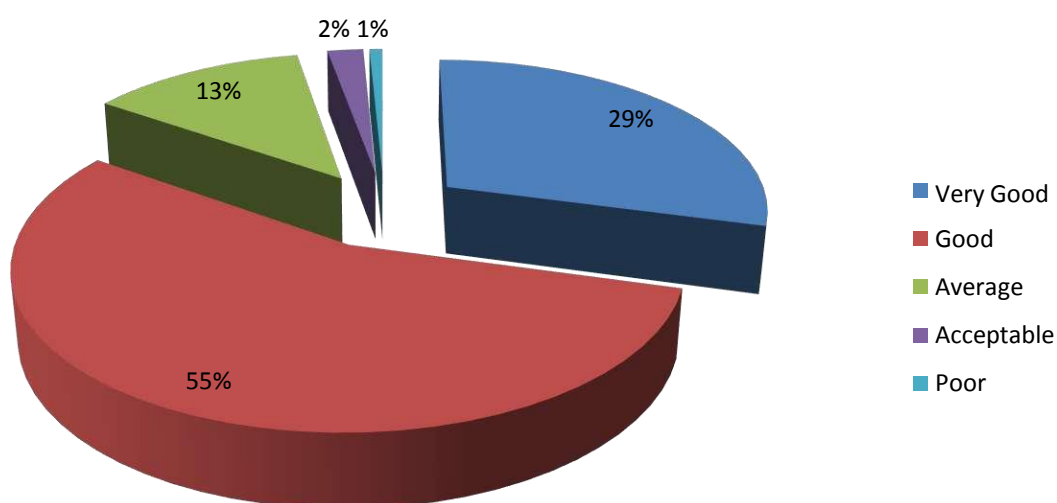
AVAILABILITY OF REFERENCE BOOKS

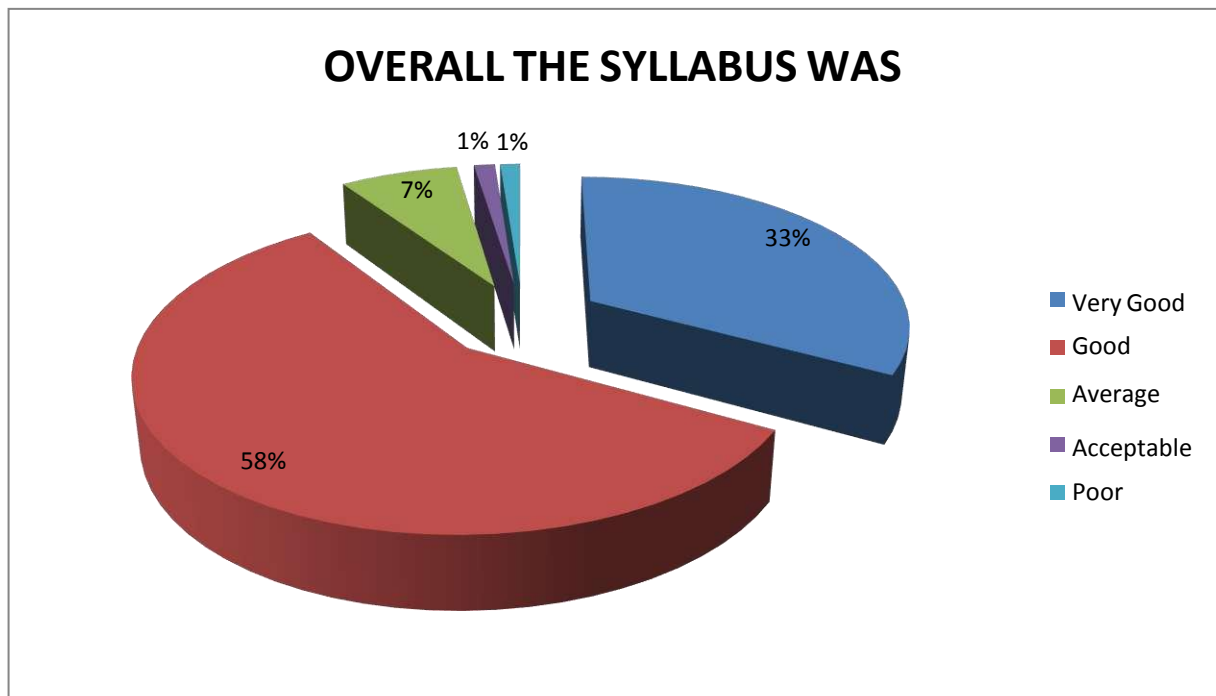
Did syllabus fulfill the Expectation?

DID SYLLABUS FULFIL YOU EXPECTATION



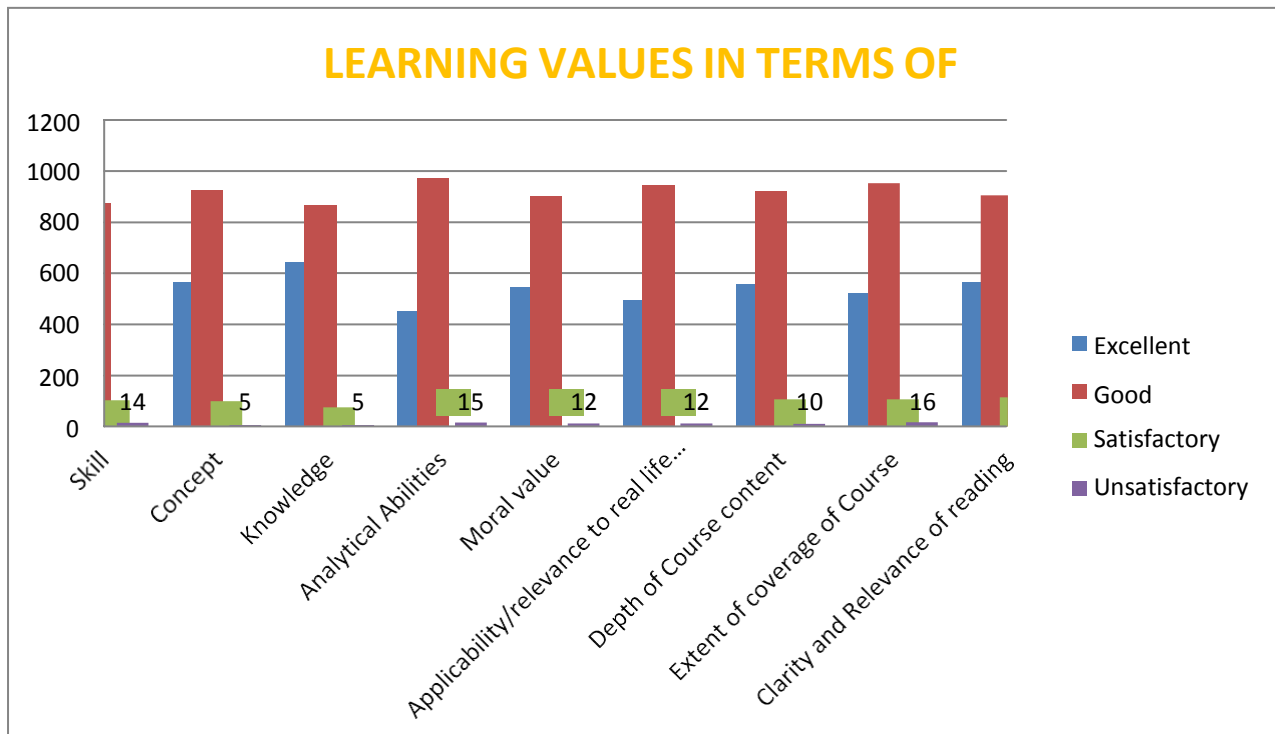
29% consider that the syllabus fulfils the expectation is very good while 55% consider it good, 13% average, 2% acceptable and 1% poor.

Overall the syllabus was

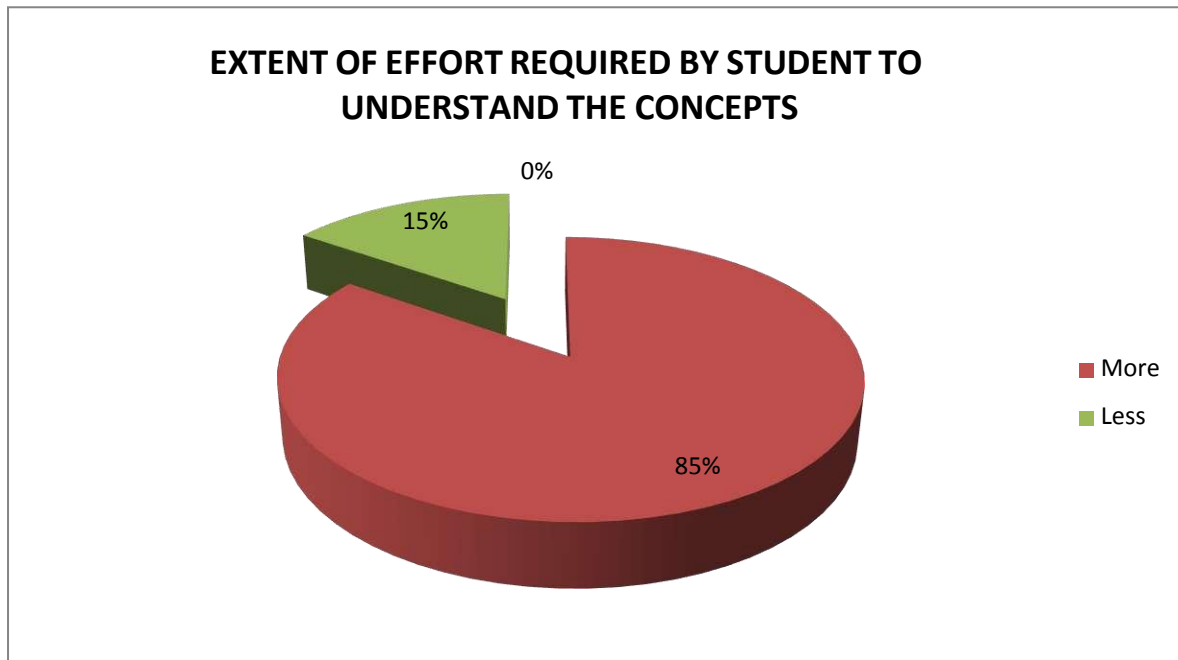


33% consider that the overall the syllabus was excellent while 58% consider it good, 7% average, 1% considered as Acceptable and 1% Poor.

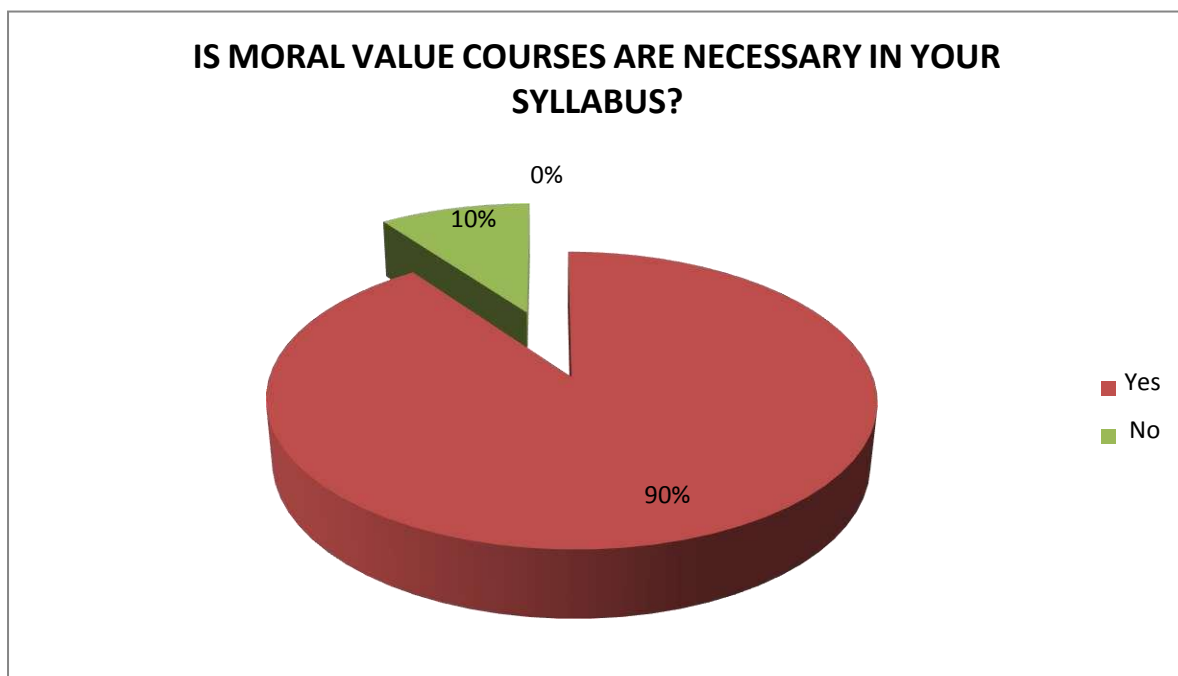


3. Extent of effort required by student to understand the concepts



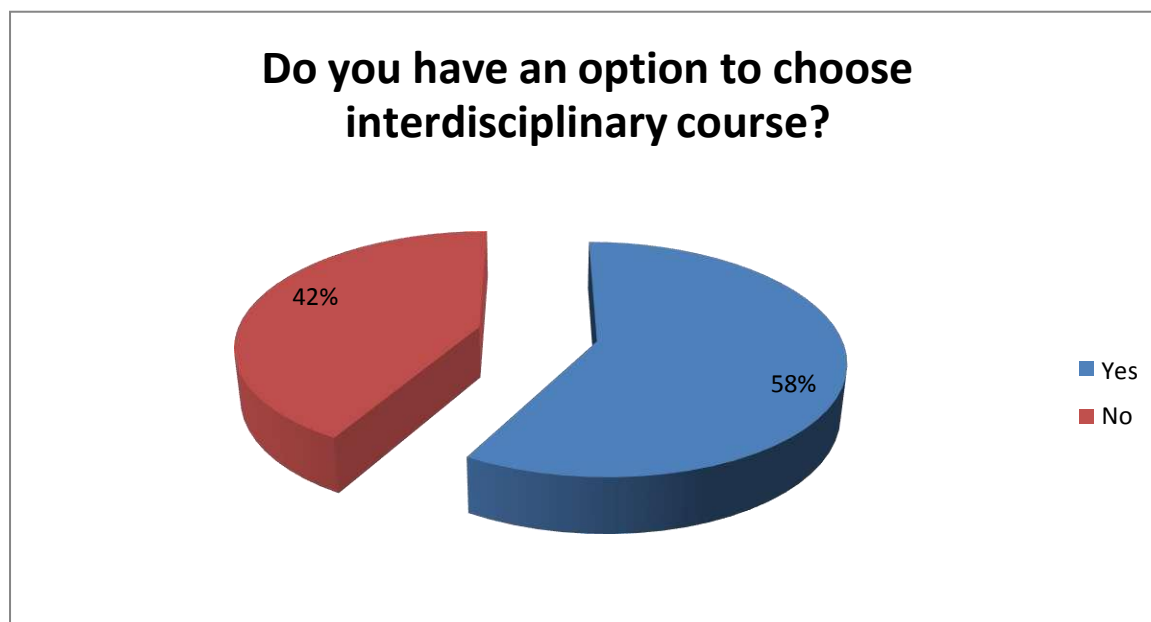
85% of students consider that the extents of effort required by them to understand the concepts are more while 15% consider it Less.

Students also need enhancement of employability within them. Students also need practical knowledge of computer.

Action Taken:

- As per the syllabus is concerned, special lecture series and motivational classes were organized to motivate the students on current syllabus and make them relevant to study the prescribed syllabus with in trustingly.

- IQAC periodically conduct meetings on curriculum enrichment and suggest our faculty members to use innovative methods/skills in their teaching to make syllabus more relevant and find some useful syllabi in their future studies.

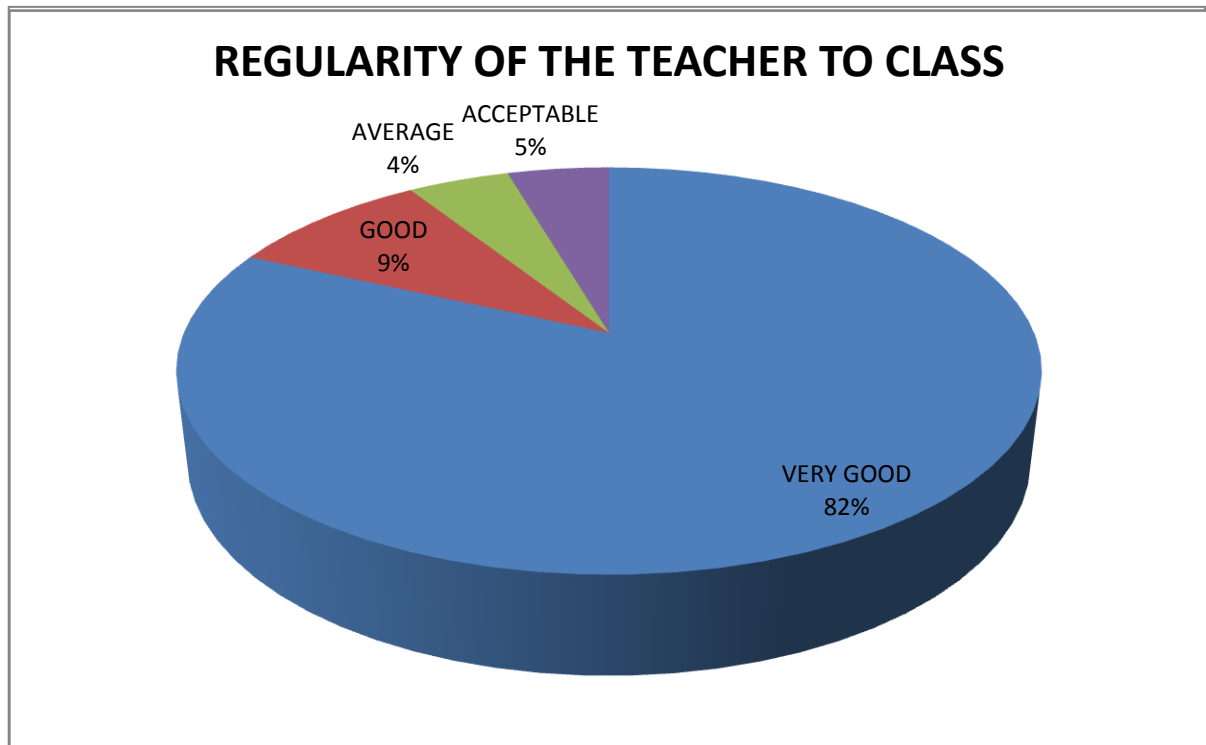

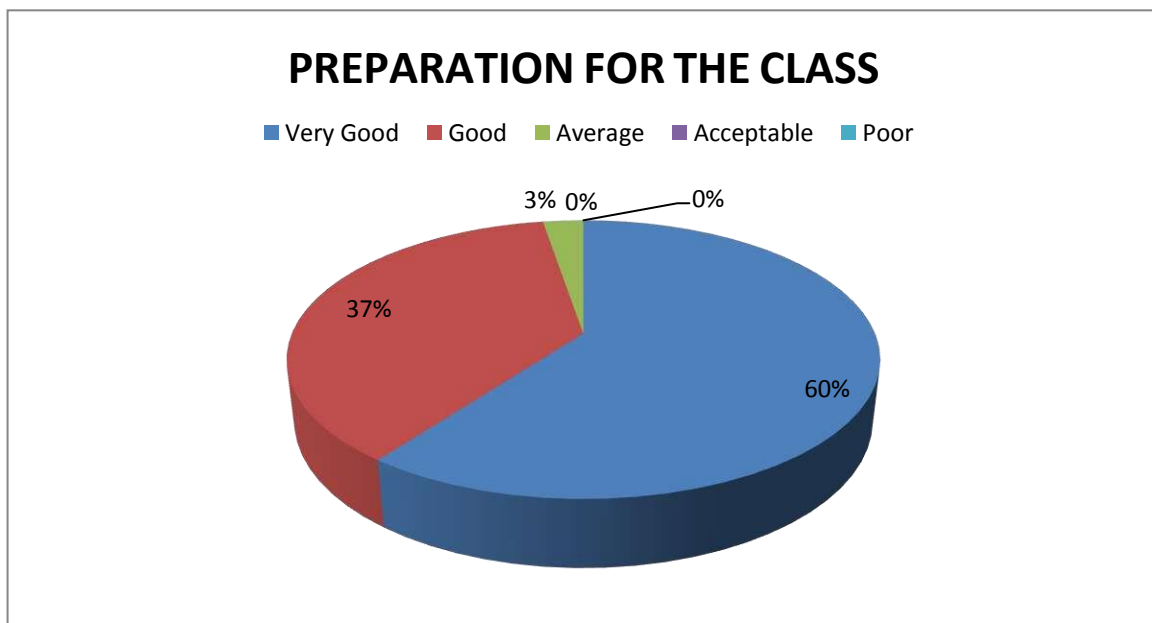

1. Regularity of the teacher to class



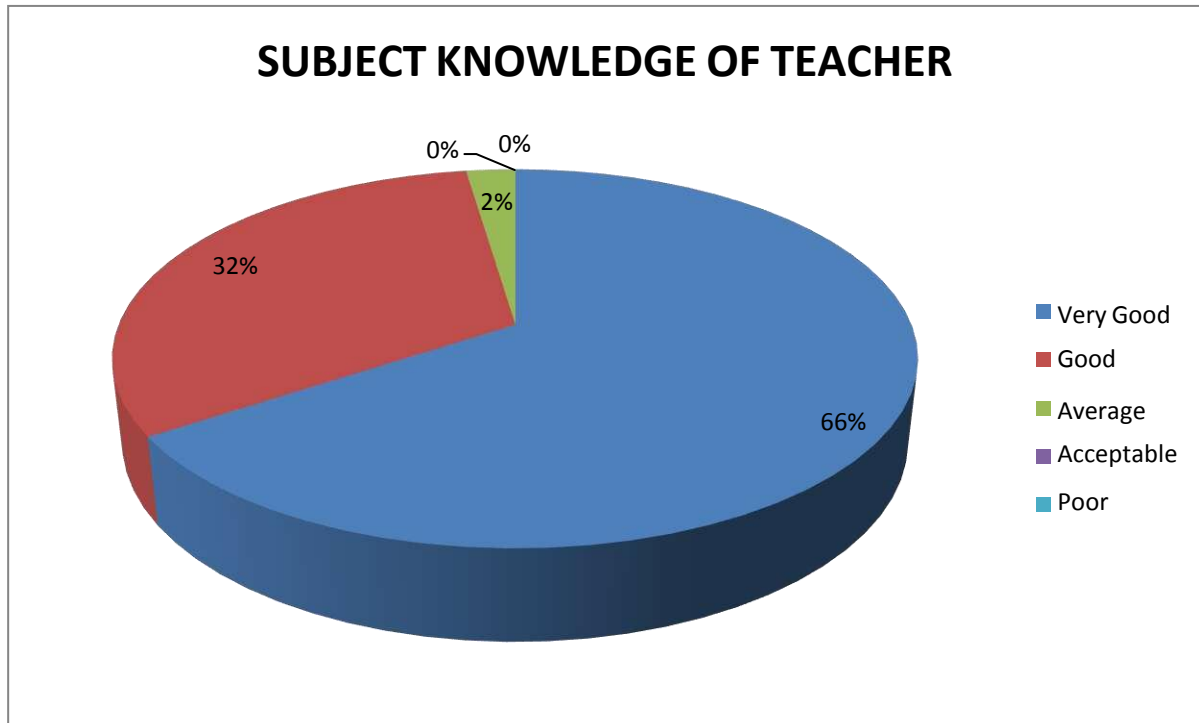

2. Preparation for the class



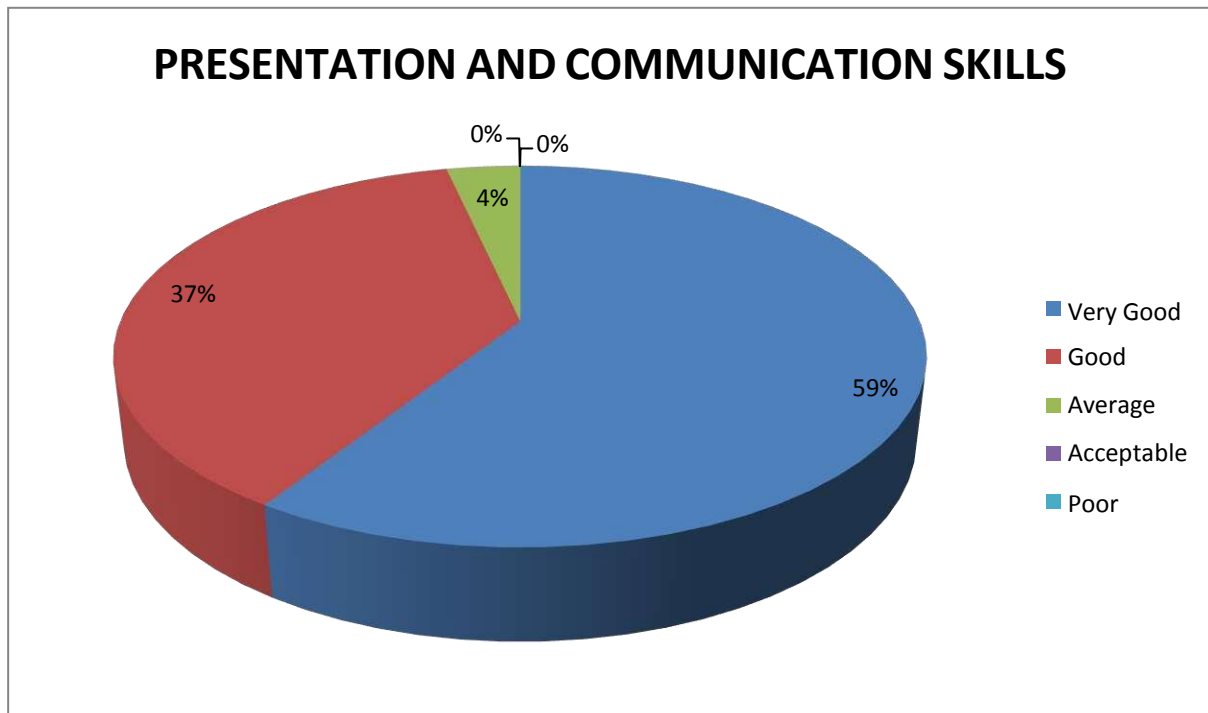
60% of the respondents are of the opinion that the Preparation for the class is very good and 37% consider it is good, when 3% consider it average.

3. Subject knowledge of teacher



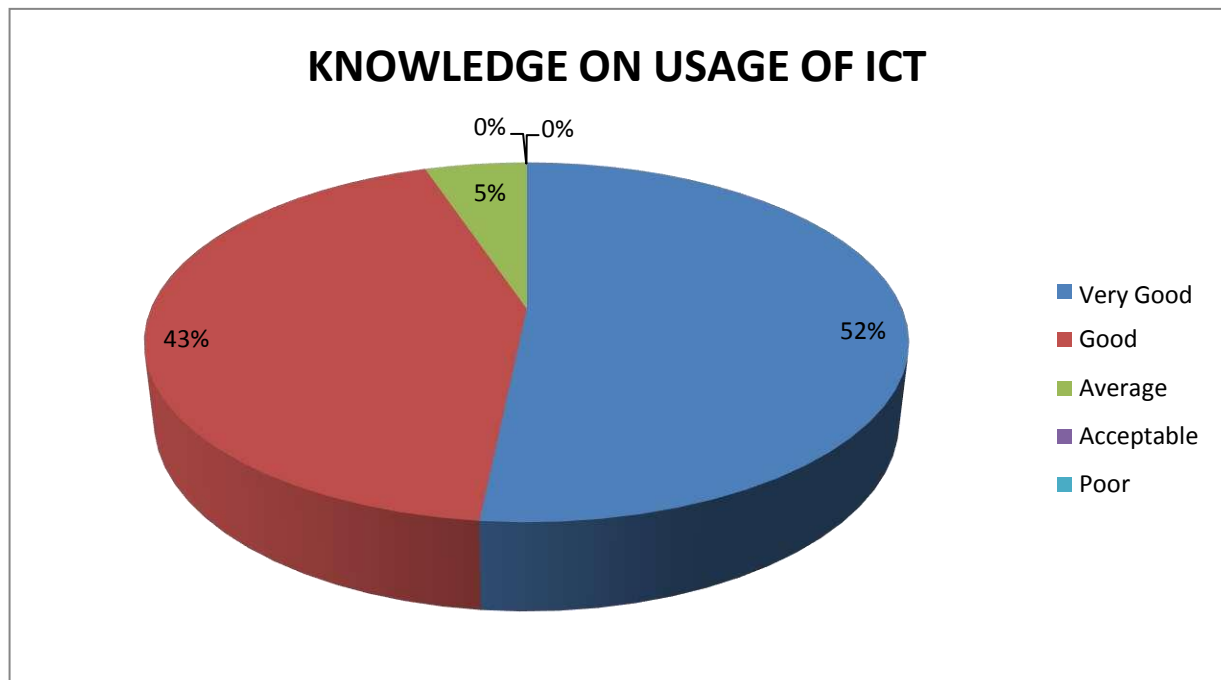

4. Presentation and communication skills:



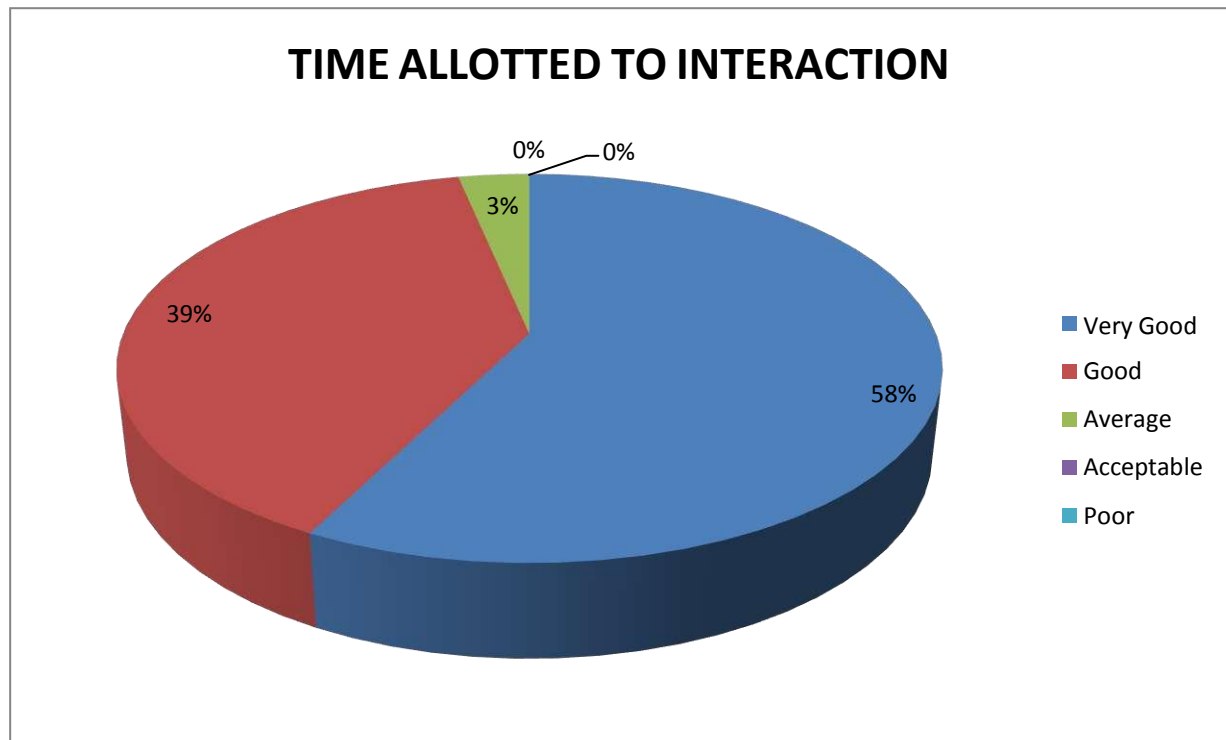
While 59% of the respondents consider Presentation and communication skills very good, 37% good, while a considerable 4% consider it average.

5. Knowledge on usage of ICT



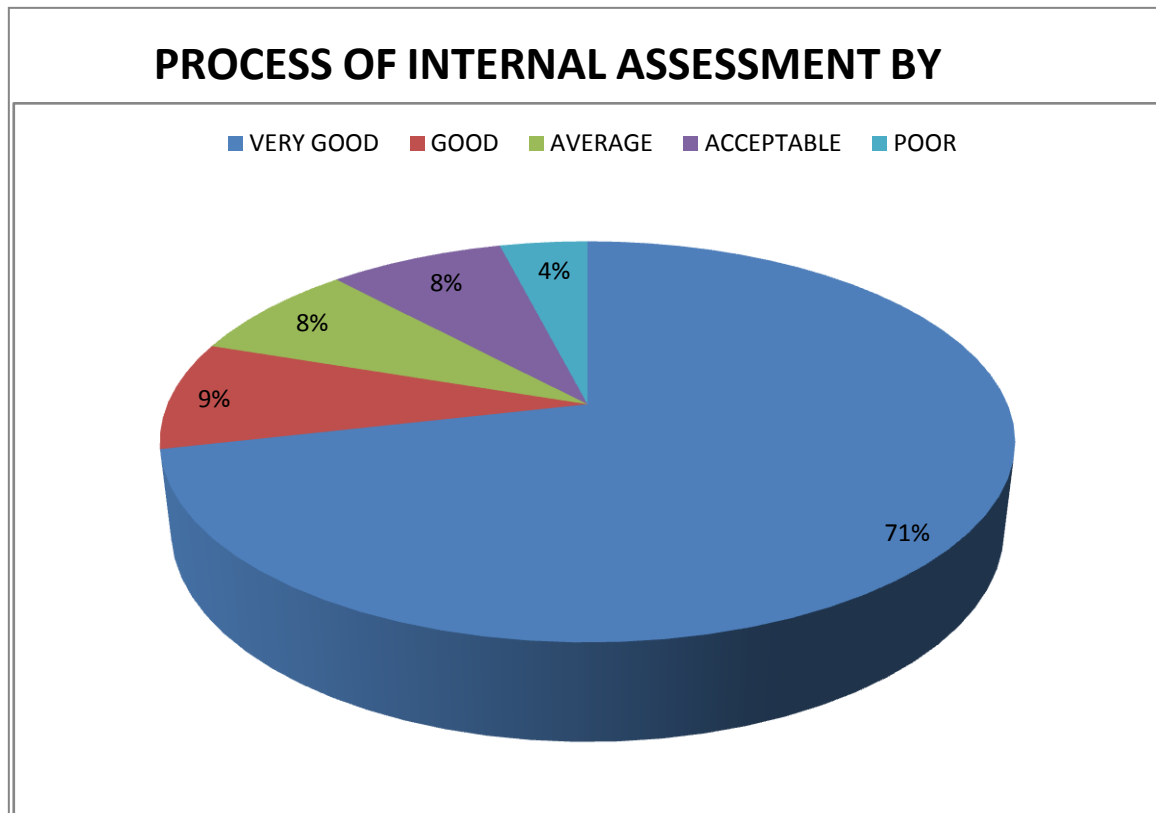
While 52% evaluated Knowledge on usage of ICT very good, 43% of the stakeholders consider it good and 5% average.

6. Time allotted to interaction



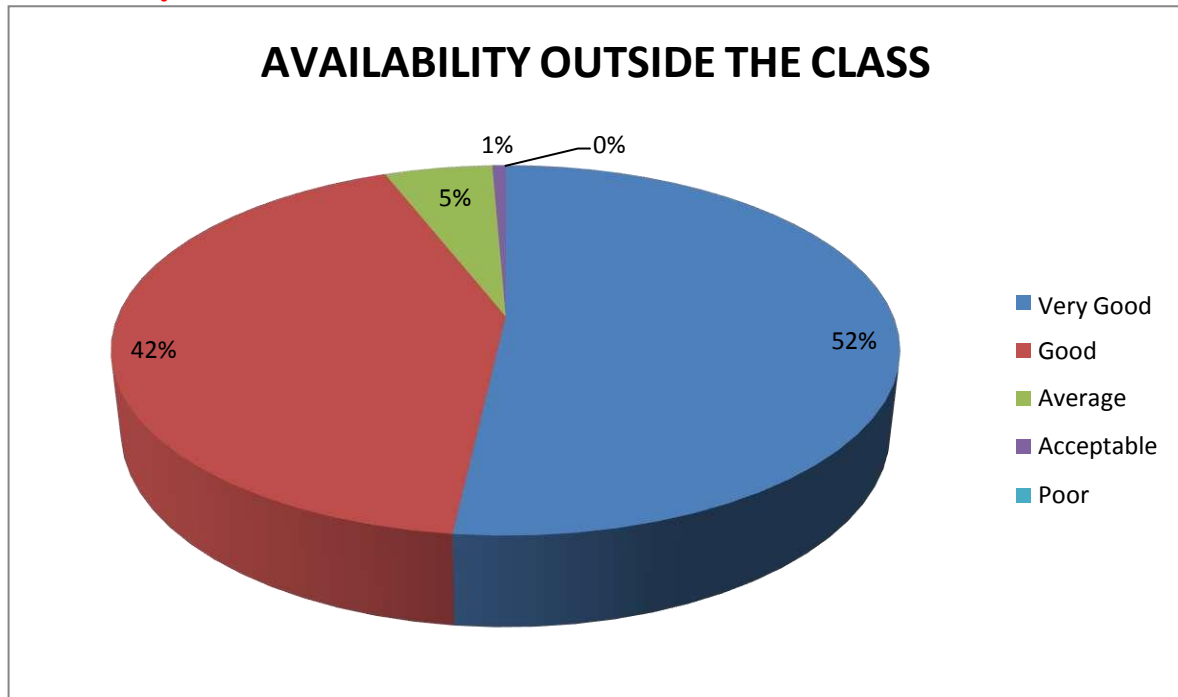
While 58% opined that the Time allotted to interaction is very good, 39% considered it good and 3 % considered it average.

7. Process of internal assessment by Teacher



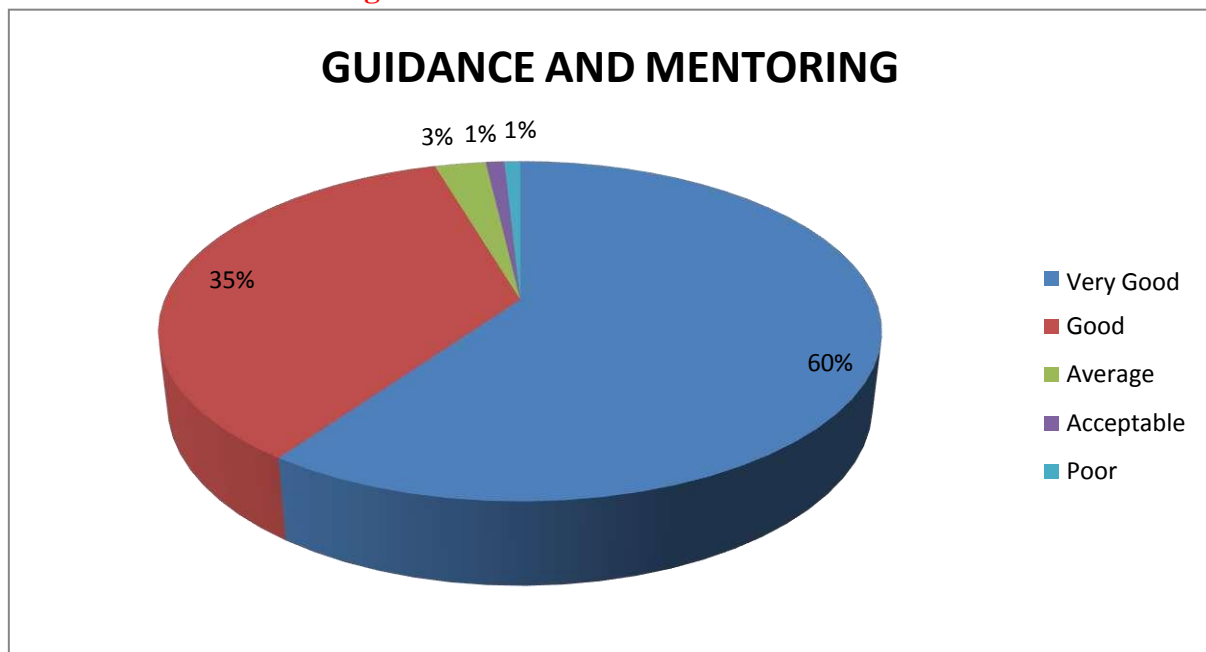
60% of the stakeholders responded by Process of internal assessment by teacher is Very good, 37% consider it good. While 2% consider average, 1% are acceptable.

8. Availability outside the class:



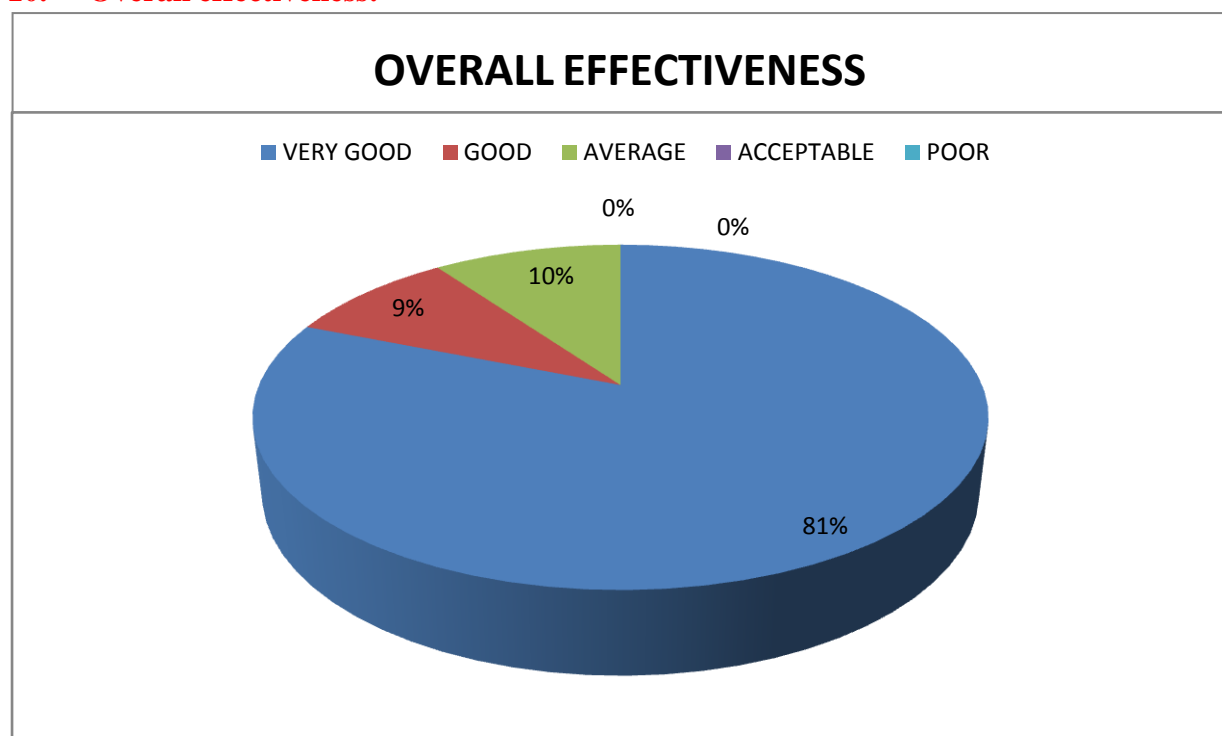
While 52% of the respondents consider availability outside the class very good, 42% consider it good and 5% average, while a considerable 1% consider it acceptable,

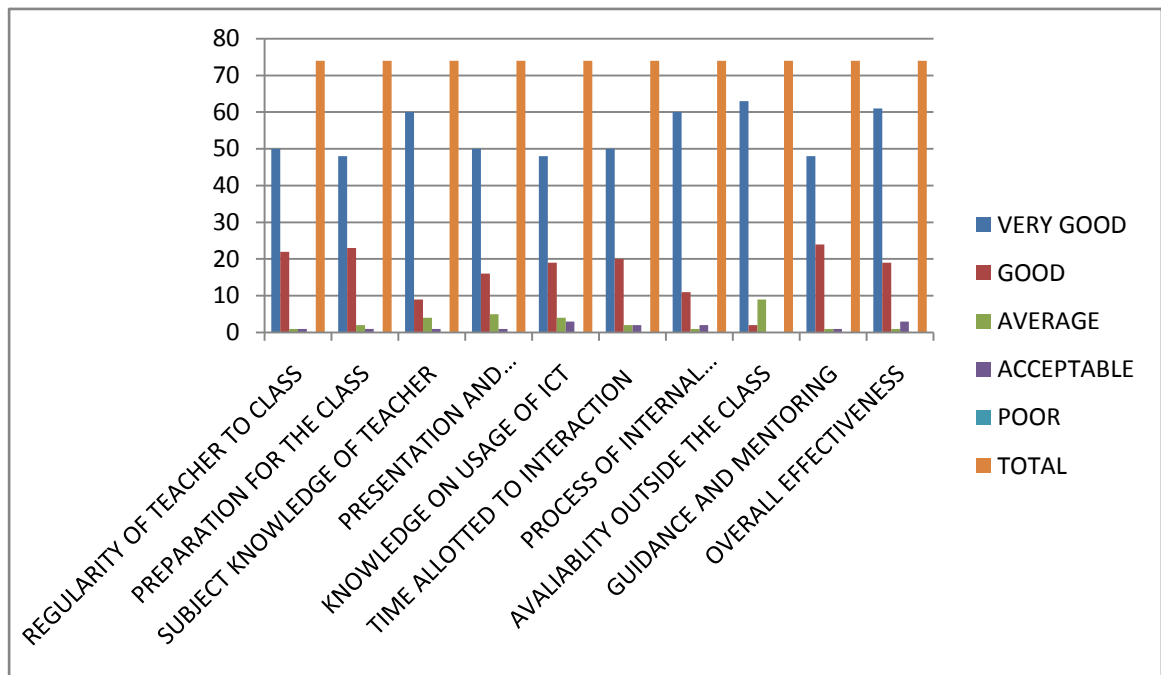

Consolidated Graph of Student Appraisal of Prof. NAGARAJA K N, 2021-22

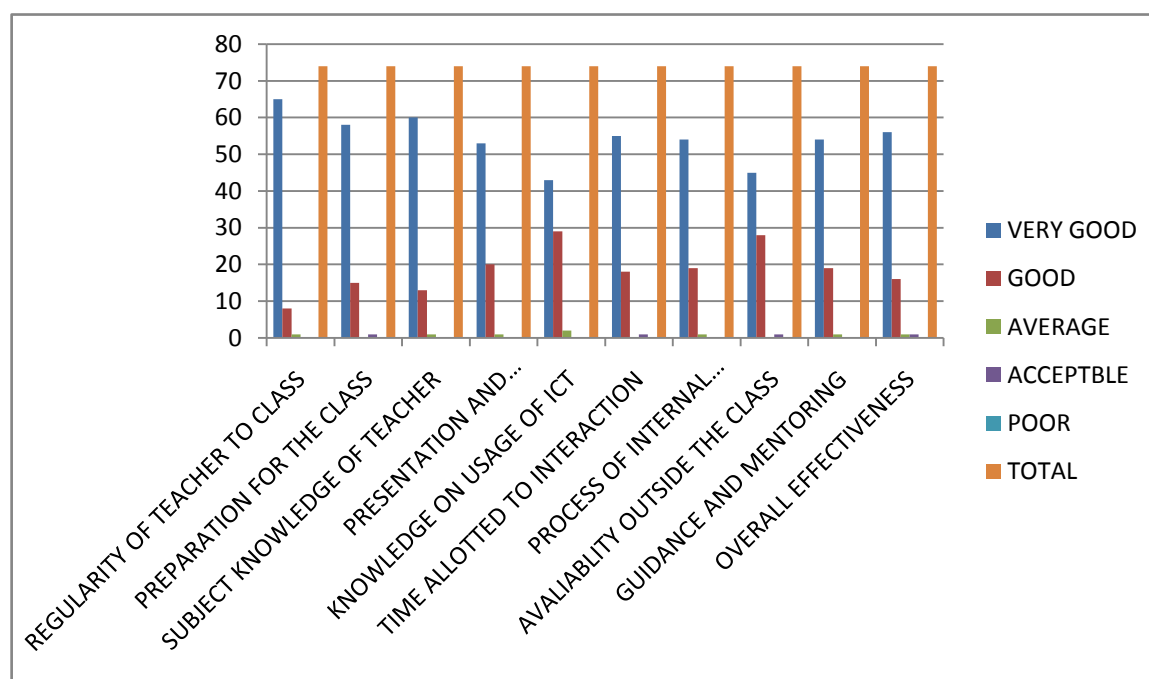

Consolidated Graph of Student Appraisal of SANGEETHA S, 2021-22

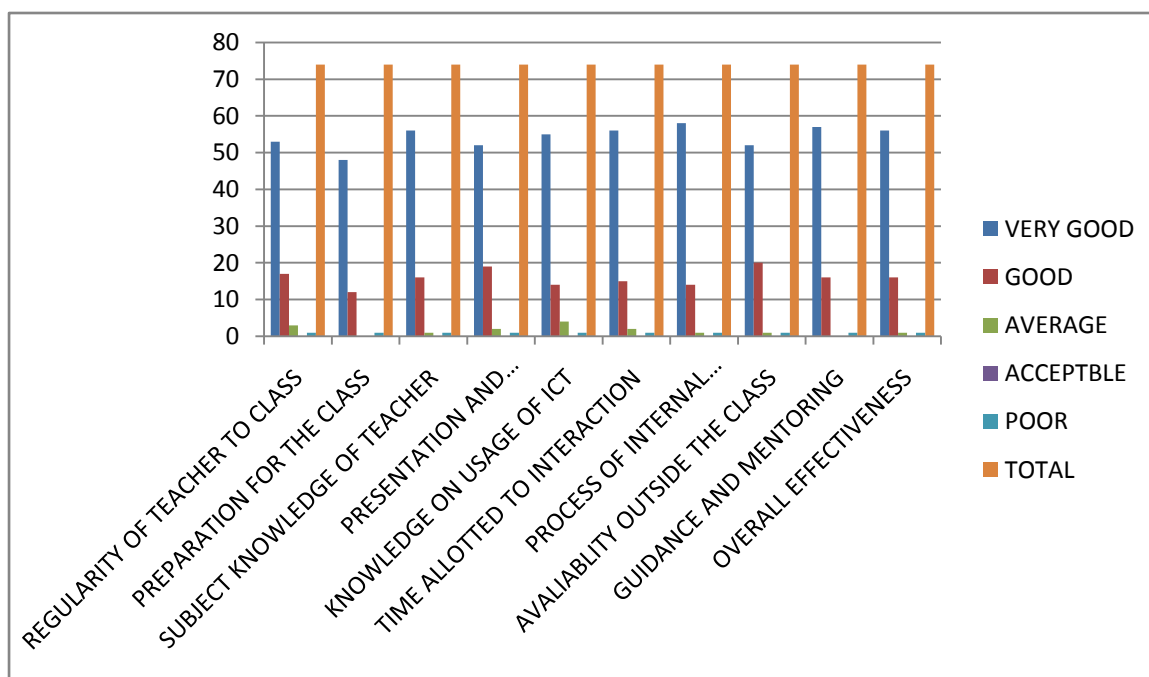

Consolidated graph of student appraisal of ASHWINI KUMARI, 2021-22

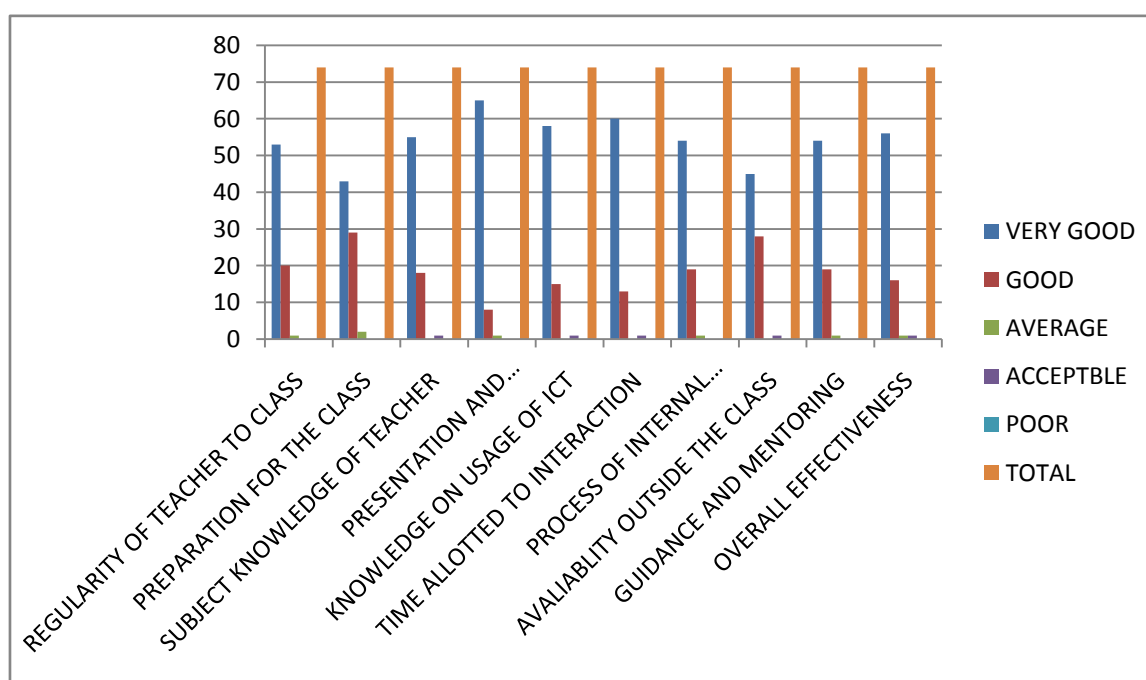

Consolidated Graph of Student Appraisal of ASHWINI PRIYA L, 2021-22

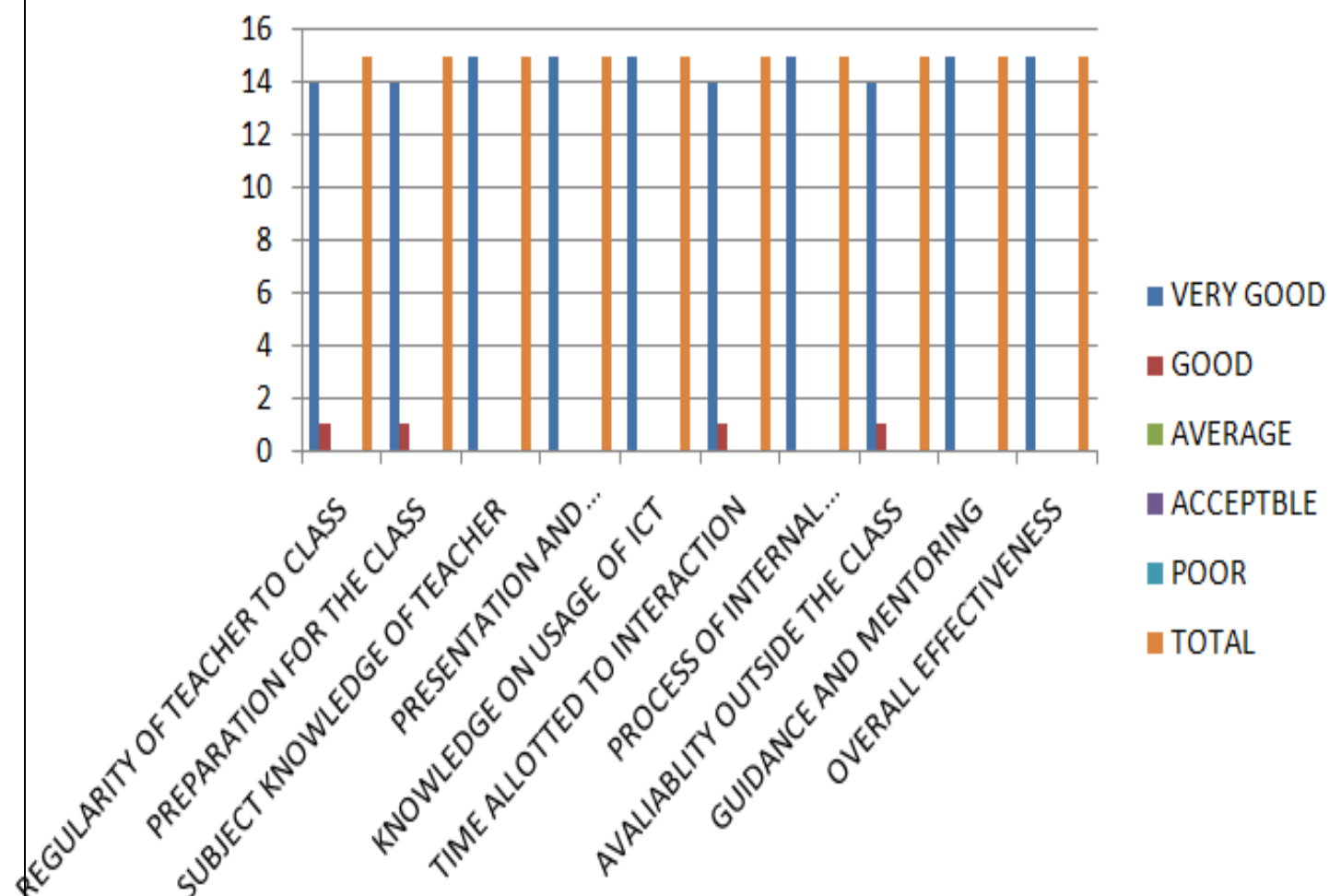

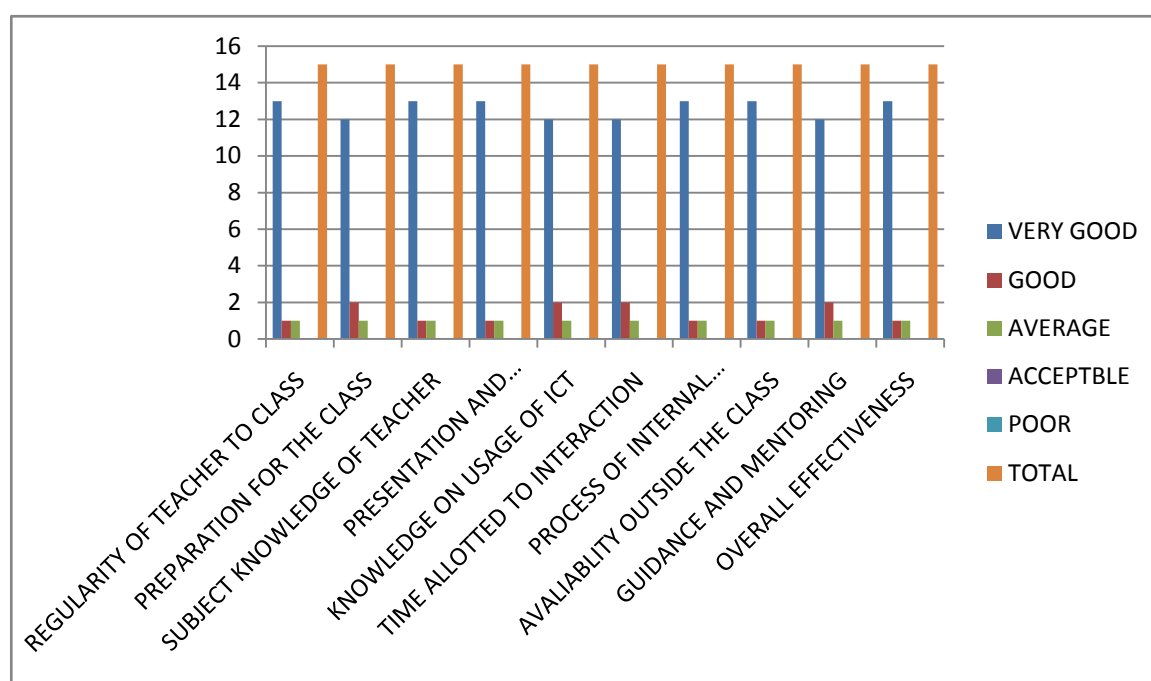
Consolidated Graph of Student Appraisal of G A HEGDE 2021-22

Consolidated Graph of Student Appraisal of C SHANTHA KUMARI, 2021-22



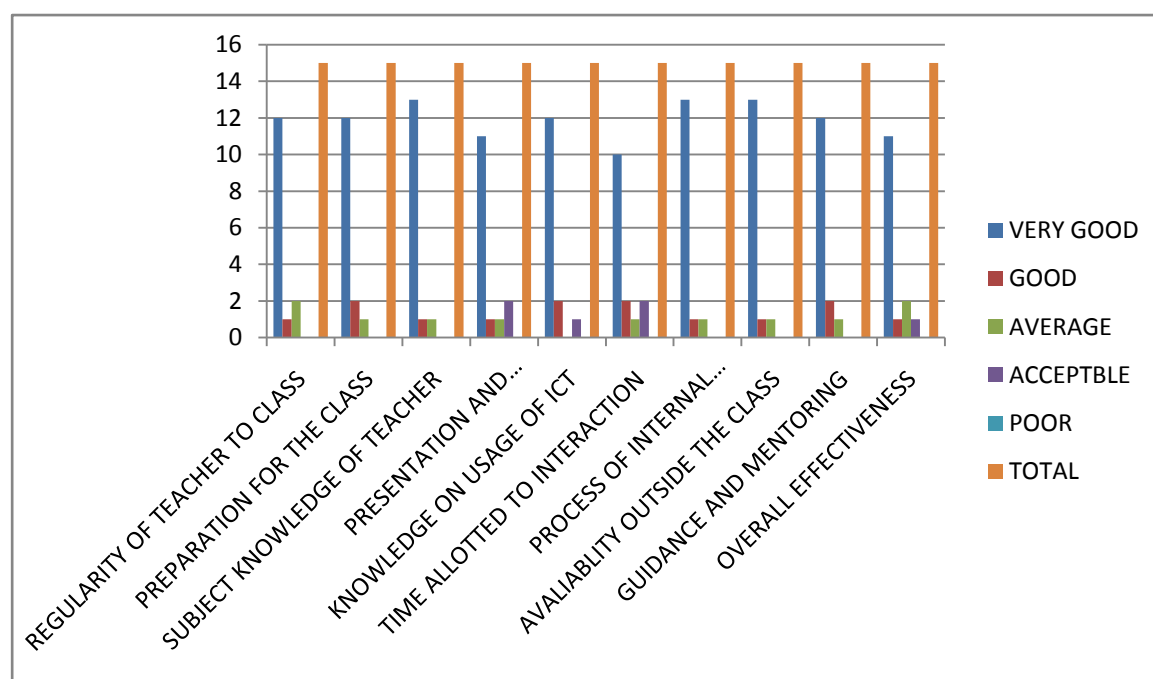

Consolidated Graph Of Student Appraisal of RATHIKA ,2021-22



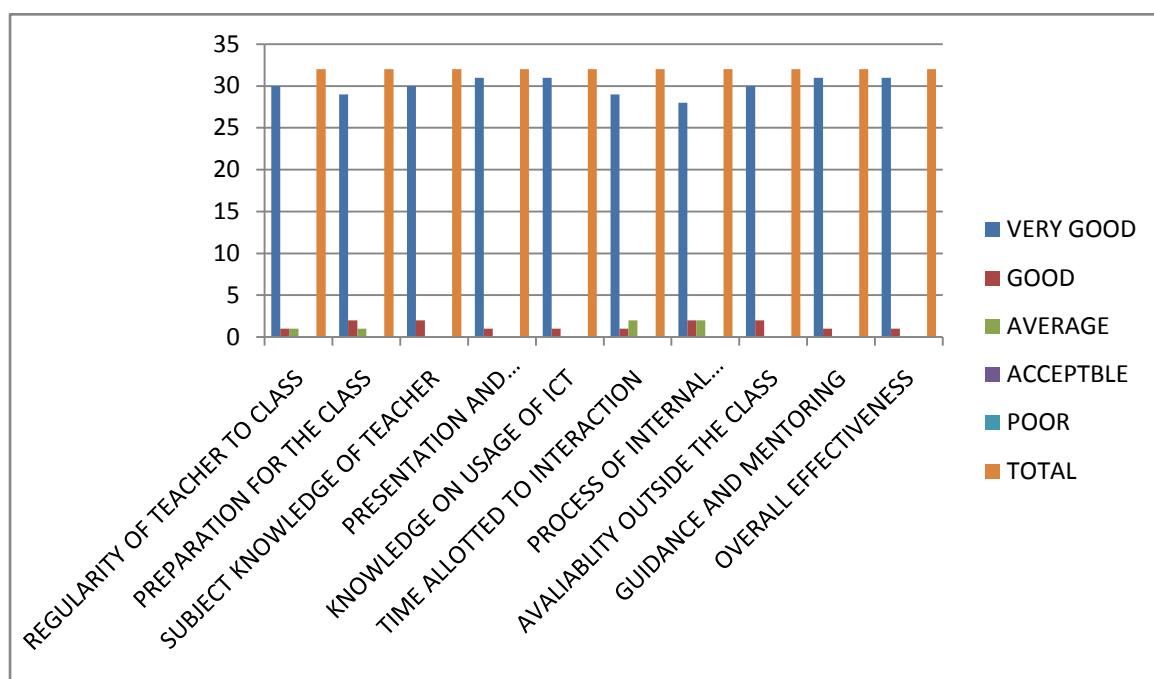

Consolidated Graph Of Student Appraisal of MADHAVI P ,2021-22



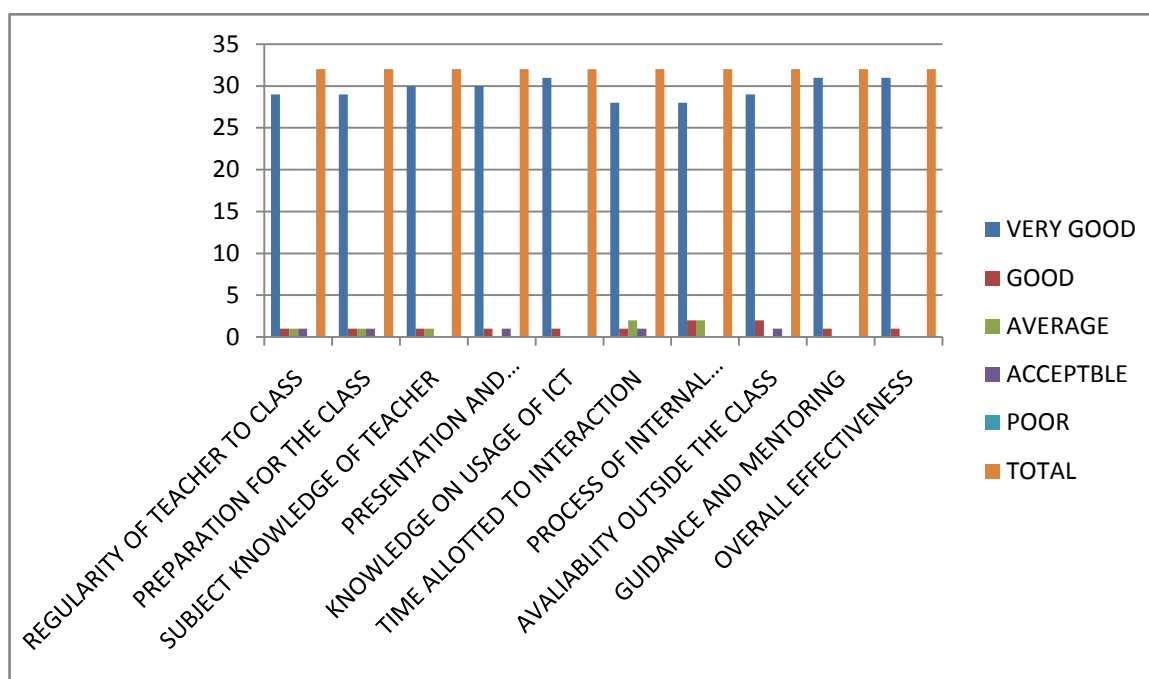

Consolidated Graph Of Student Appraisal of PAVITHRA DEVI K,2021-22



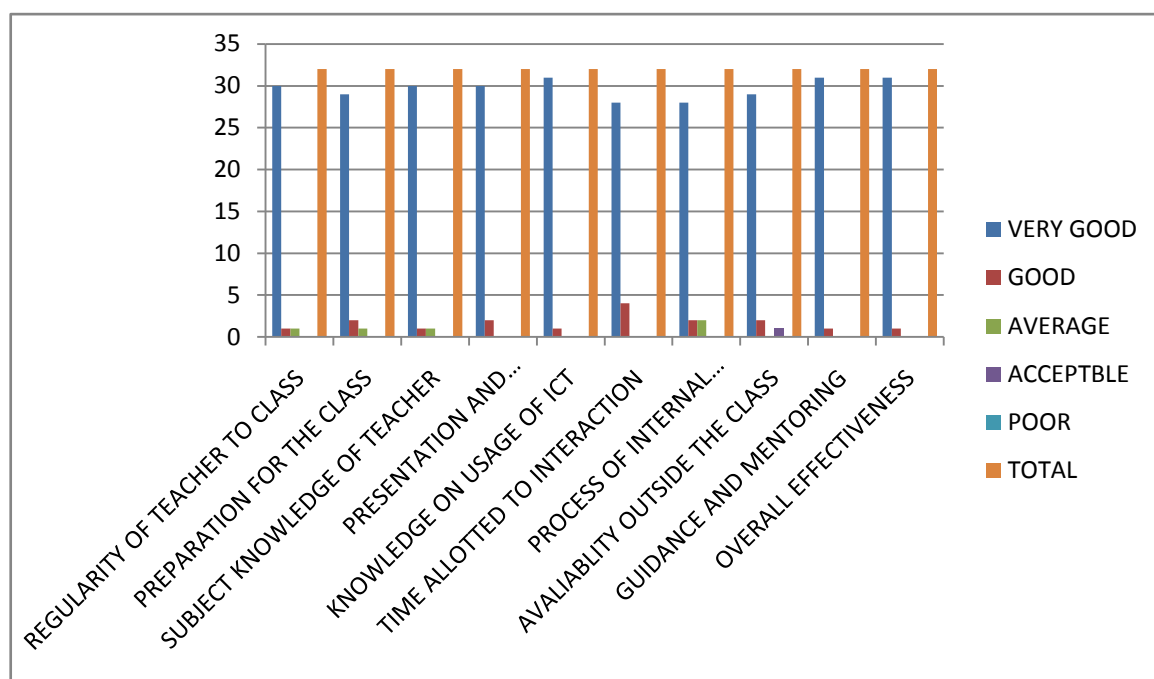

Consolidated Graph Of Student Appraisal of DEVINA MARGARET S,2021-22



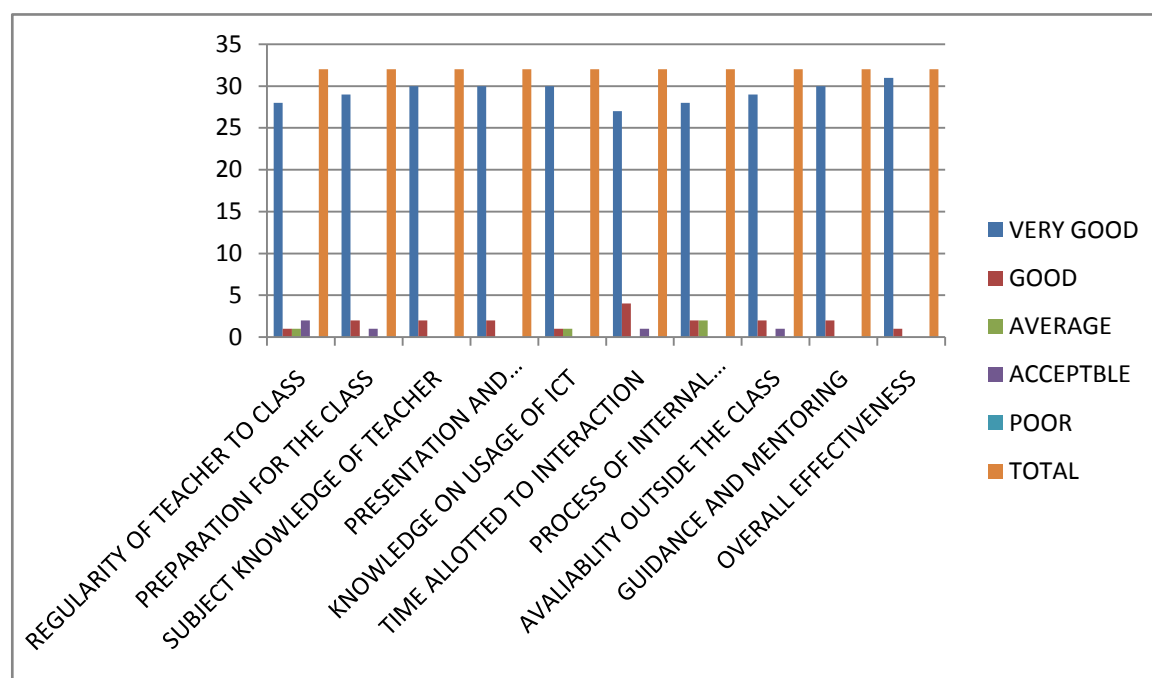

Consolidated Graph Of Student Appraisal of APOORVA D,2021-22



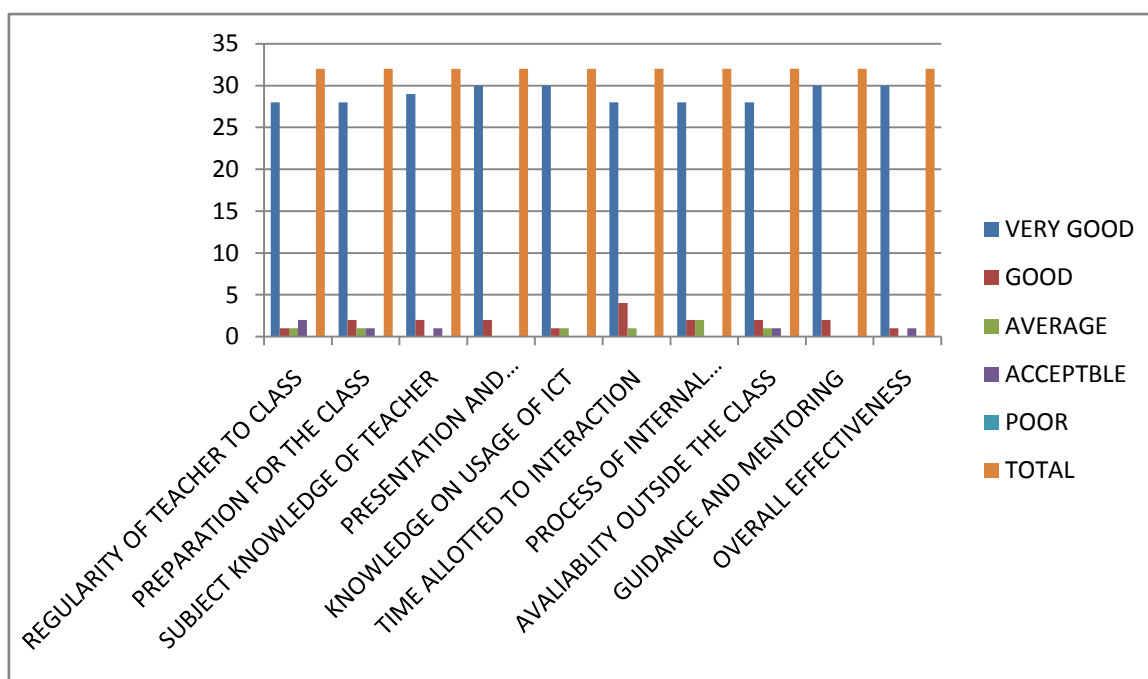

Consolidated Graph Of Student Appraisal of REVATHY M J,2021-22



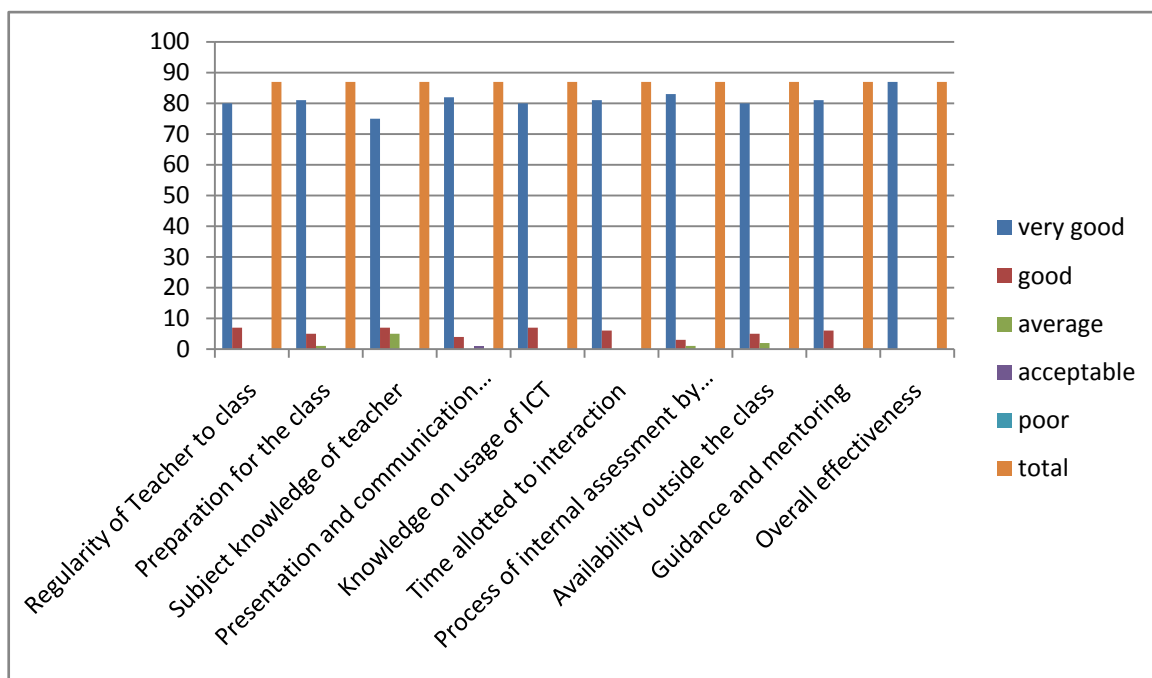

Consolidated Graph Of Student Appraisal of ANUSIYA M,2021-22



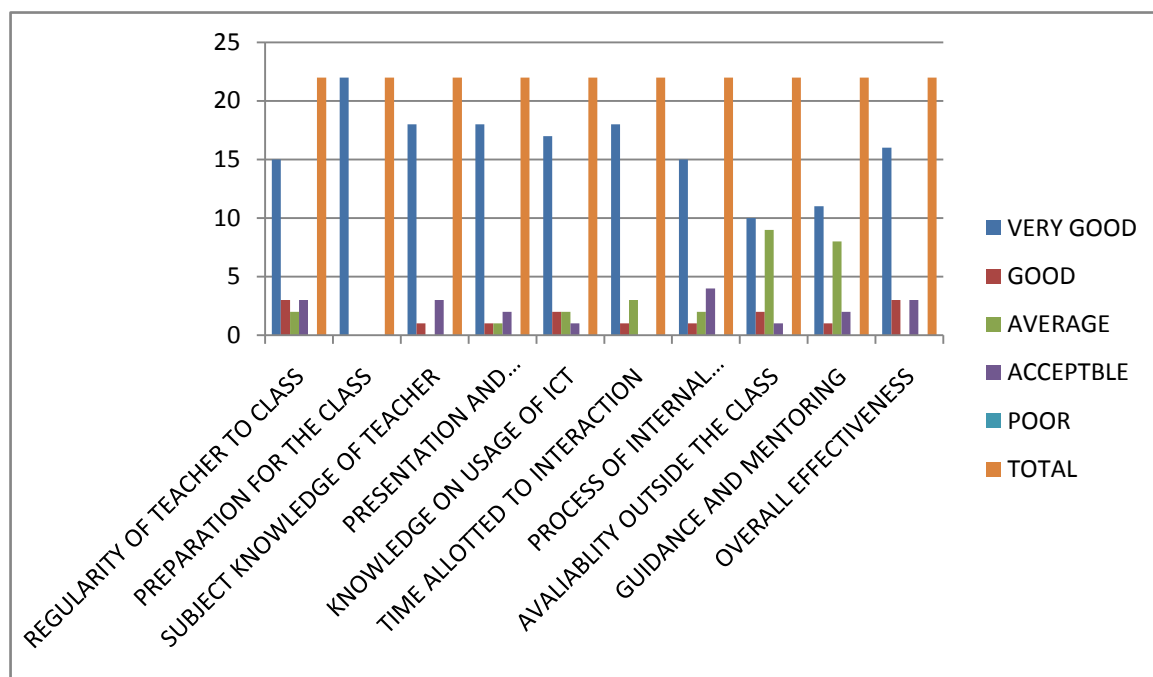

Consolidated Graph Of Student Appraisal of REETHA A,2021-22



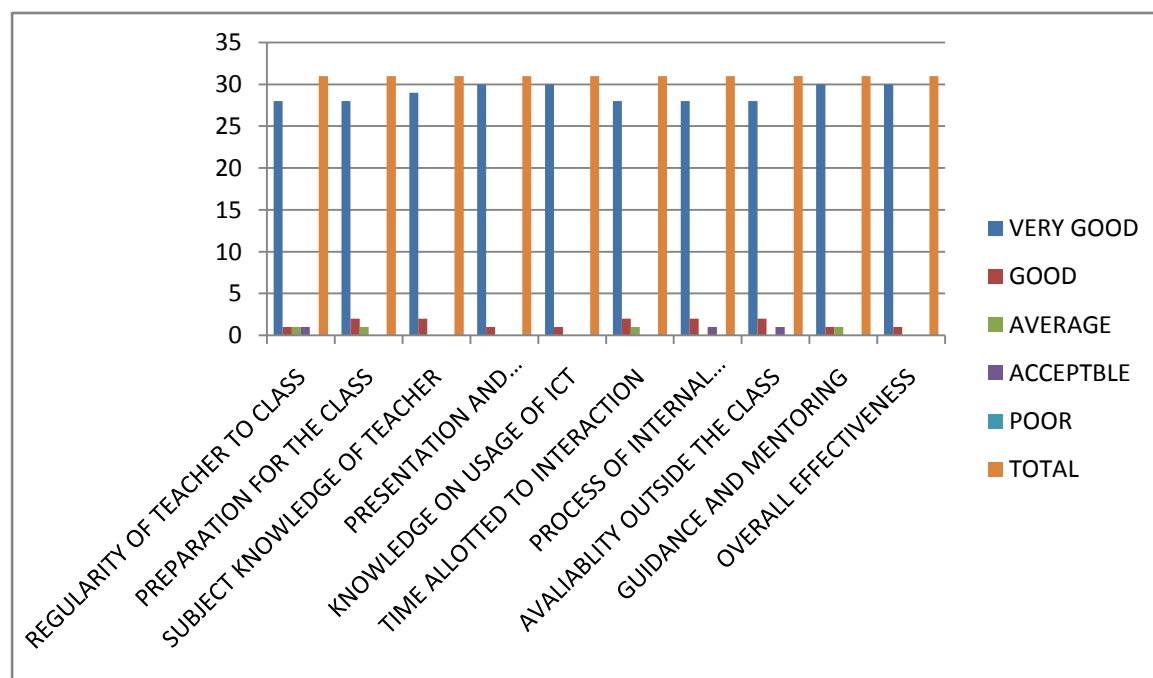

Consolidated Graph Of Student Appraisal of KAVITHA M N,2021-22



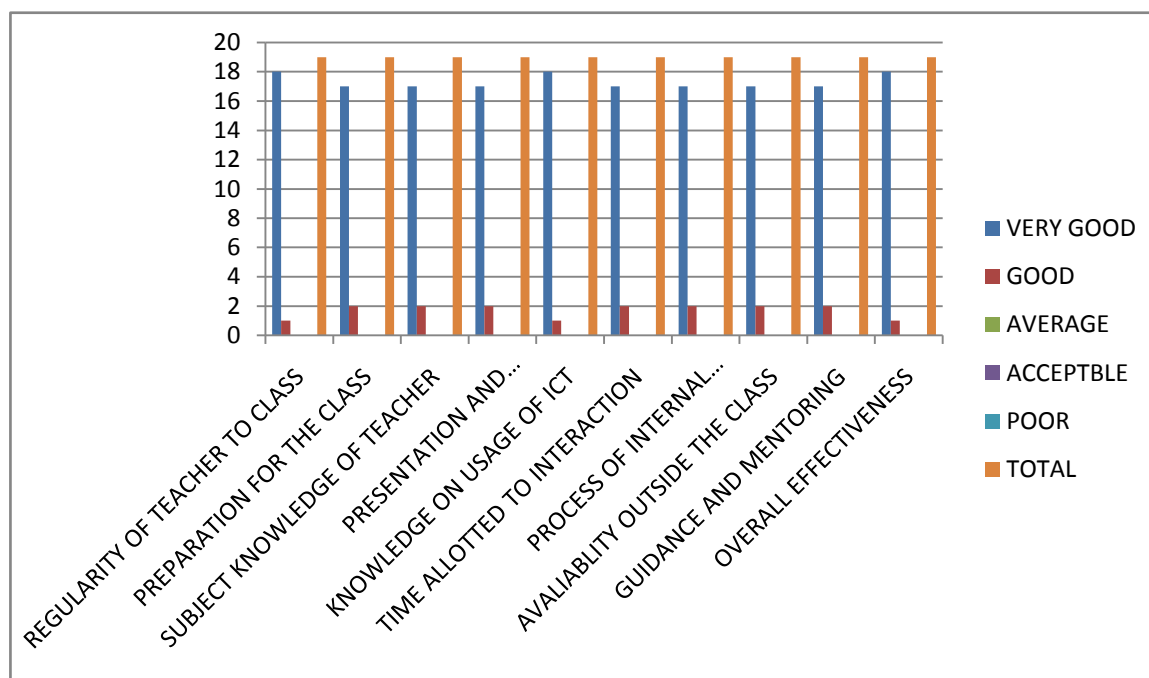

Consolidated Graph Of Student Appraisal of KOTNISE G H,2021-22



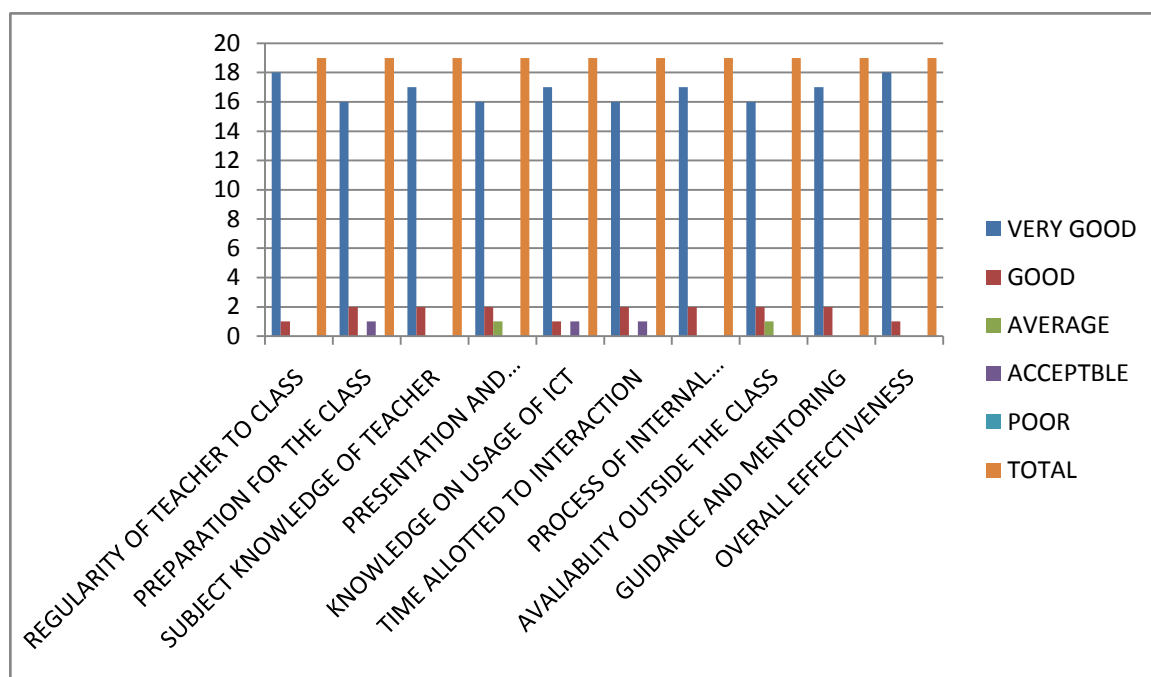

Consolidated Graph Of Student Appraisal of GANESH BABU,2021-22



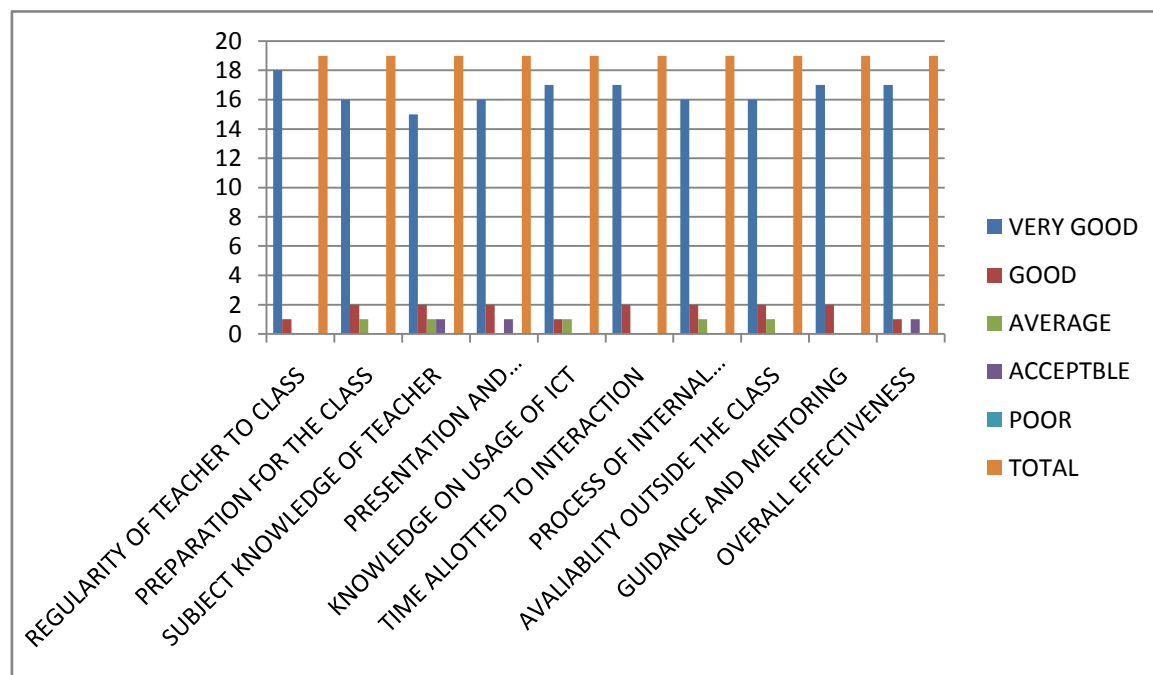

Consolidated Graph Of Student Appraisal of SANJANA,2021-22



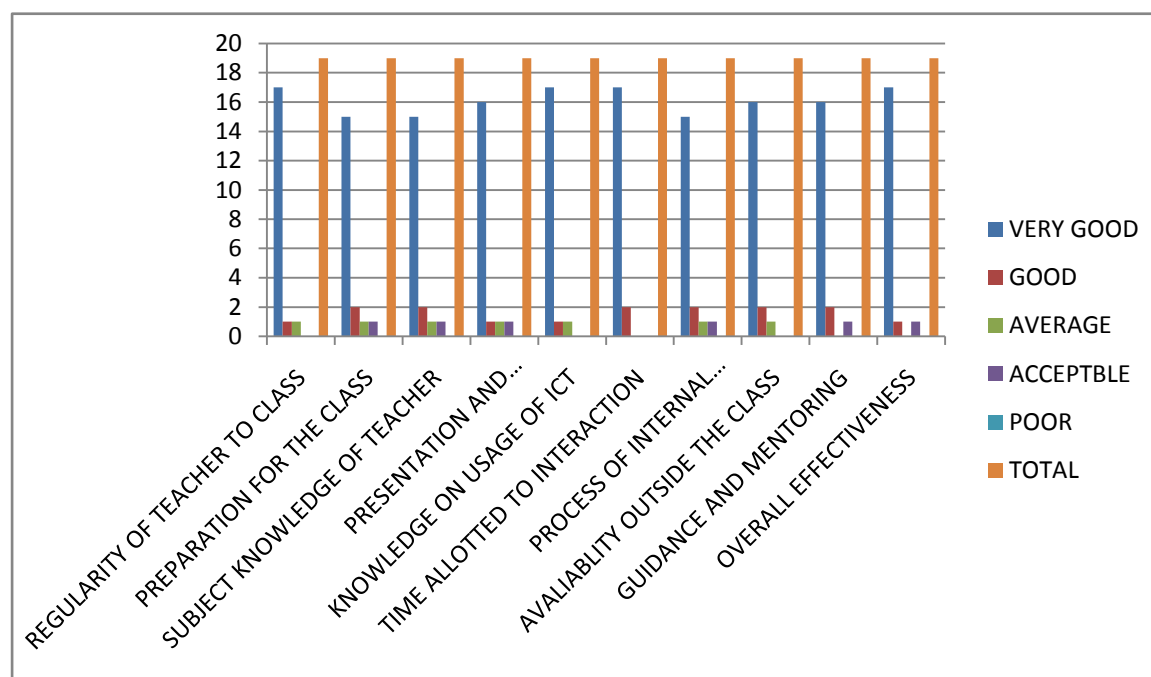

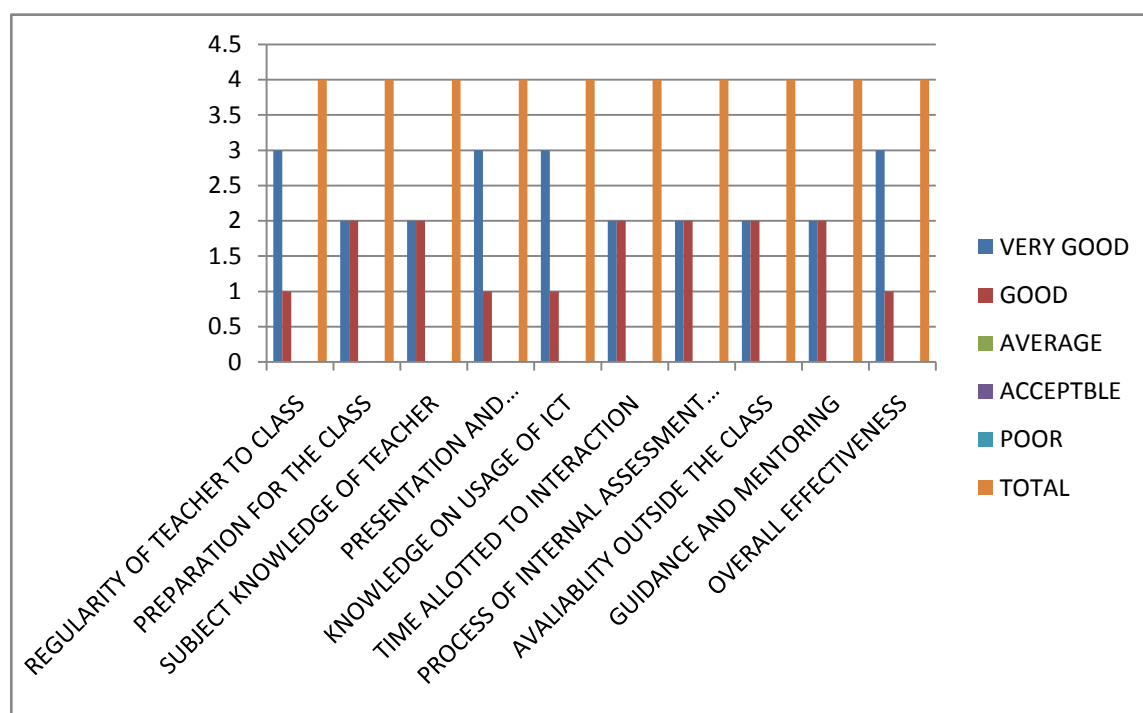

Consolidated Graph Of Student Appraisal of DR A SUDHAKAR,2021-22



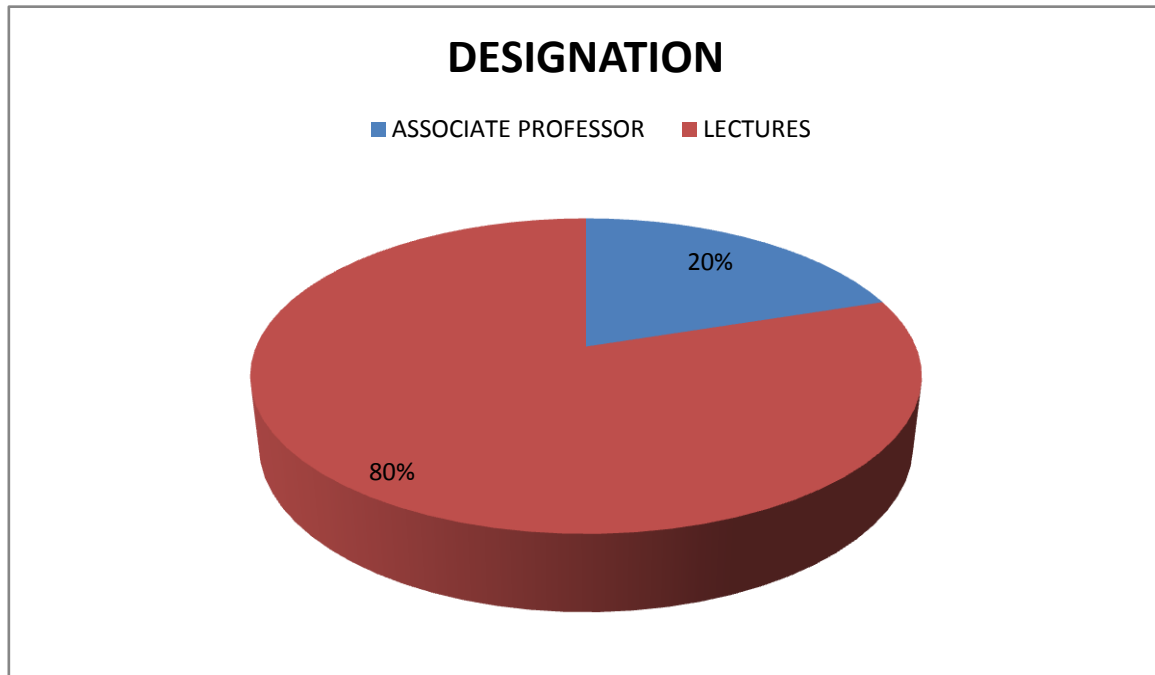
